From reading through this I doubt we ever rid ourselves of any pests. Some practical solutions are offered like checking your grocery bag for hitchhiking roaches. But if you listen just above the din, you can hear the roaches laughing. In fact, 10 percent of the weight of a two-year-old pillow may be composed of dead dust mites and their droppings. Time to go shopping! Eradication is unrealistic; there is no way to remove them so learn to live together. I laughed and moaned my way through this field guide. This does not come with a glossary nor does it have labeled images of body parts. It does have close-up pictures that were enhanced by powerful microscopes and computers. These creatures seem more like aliens or monsters found in science fiction and horror movies. You can sleep better at night knowing that bedbugs want to suck your blood without actually touching your skin. They hang on to your clothing or sheets while they drain you of precious body fluids. Did you know that when cars replaced horses many were thrilled to eliminate pollution problems of flies drawn to horse manure? Cars were considered vehicles of pollution prevention—how ironic! It was challenging for me and I find this topic fascinating. When they describe fire ants you might think that there is only one fire ant but in fact there are six known fire ants in the U.
