One dissenting justice, however, noted the state is citing the marriage amendment in its legal arguments. And Justice James Nelson, in a lengthy page dissent, wrote that he thinks the marriage amendment itself unconstitutionally conflicts with fundamental rights. He said the marriage amendment was a religious based attack meant to demean homosexuals His complaint has nothing to do with the law and how it should be applied. Indeed, he is one of a very select few people in Montana who possesses the power to impose his morality. Amazingly, he even thinks that the court has the right to judge the constitutionality of a constitutional amendment! Among the rights I think this term "rights" is being misused.
