George Parker arrives in Frantham along with his mother and sister after running from an abusive father. This way, Rina is described as a nosy and intelligent old woman who is always willing to help the police in their investigations, whereas Inspector Sebastian McGregor is shown as a cop who seems to have seen enough death and evil and hopes to spend the rest of his life quietly till he retires.
