Keep a copy of this information once you have gathered it all together as you may need it for any future application forms you complete. Make sure you are accurate and truthful. Some companies will check your qualifications and previous employers, and an offer of employment may depend on their being able to verify what you claim. Open-ended questions These may have sub-sections that structure the answer for you, e. Describe a situation where you had to Outline your specific contribution to What was the outcome of Competency based questions These are designed to measure the skills and experiences you have to offer against the competencies needed for the job. You need specific examples as evidence so before you start, think of examples to draw on and match the best example you have to each skill.
