This interest set her apart from most of the other little girls in her small hometown of Jonesboro, Georgia, where her father ran a local car dealership. Slaughter was different in other obvious ways, too. She was expelled from her Christian primary school for tearing a Bible apart, for instance; and one of her first boyfriends was an undertaker-in-training. She was also influenced by the gruesome events occurring in the world around her. Slaughter says that her carefree childhood was interrupted by the changes brought about by the fear that spread through her community. The experience sparked an interest in how communities respond to crime. Slaughter is still a Southern girl: In fact, one of her popular series of books, known as the Grant County Series, is set in a fictional Georgia town much like the one in which Slaughter grew up. One of her favorite booksâ€”everâ€”is *Helter Skelter* by Vincent Bugliosi. According to Slaughter, Heartsdale, Georgia, the scene of her Grant County series, is a composite of all the southern towns she knew as a girl. The horror grows as more women are murdered. Other books in the series continue to follow crimes investigated by Linton, Tolliver and Adams. The Will Trent Series: Trent is a man with scars, and his long-term romantic relationship with Angie Polaski is flawed. *Triptych*, the first book in the series, features a woman-killer who leaves his calling-card by mutilating his victims in a specific way. The other books in the series, *Fractured* and *Snatch*, continue to develop the characters of Will Trent and Faith Mitchell as they confront chaos perpetrated on citizens of Atlanta by criminals and serial murderers. *Georgia On Her Mind*: Sara Linton has moved from Heartsdale to the big city and encounters Faith Mitchellâ€”and her partner Will Trentâ€”in the hospital. This series presents the best of two worlds for Slaughter fans. Books in the Georgia series include *Fallen*, *Broken*, and *Undone*. Her writing is realistic and unsparing, and she goes out of her way to make sure that the details are true to life. The first main book is about two sister whose life gets shattered in the very first few pages of the book. It is more a psychological thriller with lots of twists and turns. In this book, the main protagonists are not police detectives and seasoned investigators. They are just regular, average people. As usual, Pretty Girls is also infused with a bit of gore, bordering on horror, with graphic- and grizzly descriptions of the crime scenes and deeds. The Kept Woman is so far the latest Karin Slaughter Will Trent book, in which the Georgia investigator is brought in to check out a case where the victim is a dirty ex-policeman who was found at a construction site belonging to a basketball star whom Trent investigated for rape, and the guy walked. The book is a worthy continuation to the Will Trent series, however, before you pick up The Kept Woman, make sure to read the series in order starting from Triptych, else many things might not make a whole lot of sense.
