Ladybird Books – Ladybird Books is a London-based publishing company, trading as a stand-alone imprint within the Penguin Group of companies. The Ladybird imprint publishes mass-market childrens books, the company traces its origins to 1871, when Henry Wills opened a bookshop in Loughborough, Leicestershire. From the start, the company was identified by a logo, at first with open wings. The ladybird logo has undergone several redesigns, the latest of which was launched in 1997. In the 1950s and 1960s the companys Key Words Reading Scheme was heavily used by British primary schools and this series of 36 small-format hardback books presented stereotyped models of British family life – the innocence of Peter and Jane at play, Mum the housewife, and Dad the breadwinner. Many of the illustrations in this series were by Harry Wingfield, in the 1970s, Ladybird produced the Learnabout series of non-fiction books, some of which were used by adults as well as children. An independent company for much of its life, Ladybird Books became part of the Pearson Group in 1987, the Ladybird offices and printing factory in Loughborough closed the same year, and much of the companys archive of historic artwork was transferred to public collections. Imprints of Ladybird Books Ltd. They were published on 18 November 2013, the series follows a trend of other spoof Ladybird books including *We Go to the Gallery* by Miriam Elia who had previously been threatened with legal action by Penguin. It was a way of producing books, enabling the books to be retailed at a low price which, for almost thirty years. The first book in the line, *Bunnikins Picnic Party*, a story in verse for children with illustrations in colour, was produced in 1971, the book featured stories in verse written by W. Perring, accompanied by full-colour illustrations by A. The appeal of Bunnikin, Downy Duckling and other characters made the book an instant success. Later series included nature books and a host of books, including hobbies and interests, history. Ladybird began publishing books in formats in 2013. Puddle Lane – Puddle Lane is a 1970s British pre-school childrens television programme written by Rick Vanes with animated stories written by Sheila K. McCullagh, author of *Tim and the Hidden People*. A long series of books based on the stories was produced by Ladybird Books, the programme was made by Yorkshire Television in Leeds for ITV and ran on from 1971 until 1973. The main characters were the Magician, and a Spell Dragon named Toby, the Magician told Toby stories by moving his finger around in a puddle and he also had a cauldron inside and water barrel outside, both of which could talk. The stories he told were presented as animations, narrated by Kate Lee, the Magician lived in a large house at the end of Puddle Lane, hence the name of the programme. The texts, based on the stories, were written by Sheila McCullagh. Illustrations for the books were provided by different artists.
