

Chapter 1 : Statistical Yearbook | BFI

The Statistical Yearbook provides in a single volume a comprehensive compilation of internationally available statistics on social and economic conditions and activities, at world, regional and national levels, for an appropriate historical period.

It covers data for and key statistical data in recent years and some historically important years at the national level and the local levels of province, autonomous region and municipality directly under the Central Government. The Yearbook contains twenty-seven chapters: Employment and Wages; 5. Resources and Environment; 9. Investment in Fixed Assets; Foreign Trade and Economic Cooperation; Wholesale and Retail Trades; Hotels, Catering Services and Tourism; Science and Technology; Public Health and Social Services; Culture and Sports; Urban, Rural and Regional Development; To facilitate readers, the Brief Introduction at the beginning of each chapter provides a summary of the main contents of the chapter, data sources, statistical scope, statistical methods and historical changes. The national data in this book do not include those of the Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, the Macao Special Administrative Region and Taiwan Province, except for the divisions of administrative areas, the area of the national territory and forest resources and otherwise specified. In accordance with the principles set down in the Basic Law of Hong Kong Special Administrative Region, and the Basic Law of Macao Special Administrative Region, statistically Hong Kong, Macao and the mainland of China are three mutually independent regions, each following its own and different statistical systems and legal provisions in conducting statistical operations independently. Eastern region, central region, western region and northeastern region in the Yearbook are divided as following: Eastern 10 provinces municipalities include: Liaoning, Jilin and Heilongjiang. The units of measurement used in the Yearbook are internationally standard measurement units, and newly published and implemented Product Categories are uniformly used. Please refer to the newly published version of the Yearbook for updated historical data. Statistical discrepancies on totals and relative figures due to rounding are not adjusted in the Yearbook. In comparison with China Statistical Yearbook , following revisions have been made in this new version in terms of the statistical contents and in editing:

The Statistical Yearbook is the thirty-sixth annual edition of the publication, which details hundreds of historic economic and social characteristics of the territory.

History[edit] The desirability of having a statistical yearbook was expressed for the first time on 29 June The Federal Council agreed to consider implementing this proposal, but before publishing the Yearbook it wanted to wait until the results of the census were available so they could be included in it which subsequently proved to be only partially possible. Guillaume, presented a yearbook proposal divided into six theses to the Conference of Swiss statisticians in Aarau , which was adopted after a short discussion. The first thesis described the purpose of the publication: Guillaume indicated that he had modelled the Statistical Yearbook of Switzerland on the Statistical Yearbook of Finland a thin bilingual booklet and the Statistical Yearbook of the German Reich a more comprehensive volume with coloured maps. The first Statistical Yearbook of Switzerland, weighing in at pages, was published on 8 April Apparently the response was mostly positive and the first edition seemed to live up to the expectations that might be made upon such a publication. Development over years[edit] The concept adopted in the early days of the Statistical Yearbook, which aimed to make information available not just to specialists but to the public at large, corresponds to modern principles of statistical dissemination. This explains a certain similarity in the way information has been presented for more than years: By , the " text " element also featured more prominently in the Yearbook. Statistical Yearbooks of Switzerland But not all editions of the Yearbook were modern in the sense described above: It was only for the 96th edition in that clear steps were taken to make the Yearbook more easily comprehensible and user-friendly again. As Federal Councillor Cotti put it in the foreword, the new design aimed "to bring statistics closer to the citizen". Each overview text presents a summary of key findings, analyses long-term trends and explains links between various indicators. This section, which also contains numerous graphics, is aimed at a wide audience, but is also intended to provide a useful overview for more specialised groups such as media people and politicians. The " Surveys , Sources" section briefly describes the most important data sources. The " Glossary " defines key terms. Finally, the "Data" section corresponds to a classical statistical yearbook and remains the largest section. It mainly contains tables as well as some graphics and thematic maps. The files are in PDF format and show the original typography, but electronic search options make it possible to consult the texts as easily as in a modern electronic publication. The files are quite large between 16 and 50 MB! Statistical Data on Switzerland[edit] "Statistical Data on Switzerland" is a clearly presented booklet which is updated every year and is intended to provide an "iron ration" of the most important key figures for Switzerland.
