

**Chapter 1 : Lot Detail - Reggie White Game Used Green Bay Packers Helmet (MEARS)**

*On December 5, , the Philadelphia Eagles retired his jersey in a halftime ceremony during the Eagles' Monday Night Football game with the Seattle Seahawks, which were coached by Mike Holmgren, White's former coach in Green Bay. White became the first player in NFL history to have his number officially retired by multiple teams.*

Reggie White, 43, a brief bio: During his career he was nicknamed "The Minister of Defense", a title that took on new meaning in his off-field role as the founder of Christian Athletes United for Spiritual Empowerment. It is associated with daytime sleepiness, cognitive impairment, hypertension, myocardial infarction, pulmonary hypertension, and arrhythmias as well as a two- to seven-fold increased risk of motor vehicle crashes. OSA is characterized by brief periods of interrupted breathing during sleep. Typically episodes last 10 to 30 seconds and can recur at a rate of times a night. OSA occurs when the trachea is obstructed, so that a person is unable to draw sufficient air into the lungs. The cardinal manifestations of the obstructive sleep apnea syndrome are stentorian snoring and severe sleepiness. However, both snoring and sleepiness may be denied or minimized by the patient. Frequently the first clue about OSA comes from a sleeping partner who complains about snoring or long pauses in breathing during sleep. Individuals may complain of daytime sleepiness, morning headaches, forgetfulness, loss of libido, and mood changes. The gold standard test for obstructive sleep apnea is all night polysomnography performed in a sleep laboratory. Home monitors are also available, but are recommended only when a patient cannot be tested in a lab. A diagnosis of sleep apnea is based on the Respiratory Distress Index RDI -- the number of respiratory disturbances per hour of sleep apnea plus hypopnea low blood oxygen. Initial treatment includes elimination of alcohol and sleep medications, weight loss for overweight patients, and change in sleep position, ie, side rather than back. Using air pressure, CPAP works like splint to hold the airway open. Surgical treatment, which attempts to correct a defect in the upper respiratory tract anatomy, includes simple procedures such as tonsillectomy and more complex procedures such as maxillomandibular advancement in which both the maxilla and mandible are advanced simultaneously. Surgical indications include severity of apnea, degree of anatomic abnormality and failure of CPAP. Reviewed by Zalman S.

He was the first major black player to sign with the Packers as a free agent. His character, his integrity was everything any NFL player should aspire to be. While visiting various teams, he suggested he would prefer a major city, where he could minister to black youth. It was huge," Packers president Bob Harlan said Sunday. On behalf of the entire Eagles family, our condolences go out to his wife, Sara, to his children, and to all those who have been touched by Reggie throughout his life. White worked tirelessly in the offseason with inner-city youth. But his image was tarnished when he gave a speech to the Wisconsin Legislature in which he denounced homosexuality and used ethnic stereotypes. White later apologized for any harm his comments may have caused. He put his oratorical and star powers to less controversial use in after his Tennessee church was burned down. He led the fund-raising drive and condemned the rash of suspicious fires across the South that started in White was 39 when he finished his NFL career with Carolina, leaving the game with sacks. He retired for one day before the season, but then said God had told him he needed to play again, and he returned to the Packers. White retired again after the season and took a year off from football. After the Packers allowed him out of his contract, White returned to play for the Panthers. He recorded a career-low 5. White spent eight years with the Eagles and six with the Packers before a final one with the Panthers. Remarkably durable, White missed only one game in his last 12 seasons and started all but three games during that span. God has made me realize that Sara is just as much a part of the ministry as I am. There was a time we went to a prison. I got up and shared, and I gave an invitation for Christ. About seven prisoners came down to give their life to the Lord. Sara felt the Lord put something on her heart to say, and when she did, 10 other prisoners came down! One of your exciting strategies involves Urban Hope a ministry started when Reggie and his wife, Sara, were in Green Bay. Tell us about this venture. Urban Hope is being run in Green Bay. They go through a week course and learn how to put together a strong business plan. They can put that into their business. Because of the relationship we have with the business people, the bankers, and the government, we can be confident they can take their business plan to the bank. We share Christ with them and try to live out Christ before them. The Packers beat the New England Patriots in Looking back, what are your most vivid Super Bowl memories? Well, of course breaking the record three sacks in one Super Bowl. That was a big accomplishment, and winning the game was a big accomplishment. But I remember waking up the next morning "I was worn out, and we went back to Green Bay for the parade. The next day was the parade" it was a long day. A month later, we had a mini-camp, followed by another two weeks later, and again a month after that. Four weeks later "training camp. I think God showed me that there is more to life" to let the whole world know about Jesus. I think that was even bigger than winning the game. Two years ago, the Super Bowl win was an apex for you. Last year you went to the Super Bowl, and the Packers ended up losing the big game. You also had all of the physical problems to get there and then other problems later. How was your faith tested in the past year? It was a difficult year. With the Broncos, I think we underestimated them. But they did a good job. They did an excellent job of running the ball. The Broncos were an excellent team. There was a lot going on in my life last year. There was losing that game and then going to speak to the Wisconsin state assembly and the problems with my back. God showed me that a lot of times when you go through hardships, that draws you closer to Him. He played one season and retired for good after that season. What was that like? It was a lot of fun. We really saw the Lord giving me strength to endure with my back and take the pain so I could perform at a high level. Some people were ridiculing me for saying that God spoke to me, but the way the Lord has allowed me to come out has been tremendous. You went through a lot for pain with your back a year ago. With that physical pain, how difficult was it to make the decision to play again? That was extremely difficult. Nobody knew what I was going through. Nobody saw me on Mondays when I was walking like I was 80 years old. I had to battle with it all week "go out and practice and try to keep my level of play up. I not only dealt with a bad back, I caught pneumonia in the middle of the season and my blood count was low. Also, I had a rare lung disease, which caused lumps to grow on my lungs. It was affecting my wind. So I was struggling with all of that. I lost my strength and lost some weight, but I was still able to come out with good numbers. I tried to help the team as much as possible. Only Jesus could give me the strength to be able to endure that. In the process of struggling with my back during the offseason, I thought I would retire. And the Lord pretty much told me, no I want you to play one more year. I went from a sense of disappointment to excitement when He spoke to me. A lot of people have heard about the speech you gave to the Wisconsin legislature and then the commercial you did against same-sex marriages. What has been the reaction of people around the league to the stand you took? Most people who disagree with me have disagreed with me behind either a radio microphone or TV camera. I look at that kind of person as a coward. The homosexual groups were obviously upset with what you said. What do you say to someone who says, referring to the newspaper ads. These people have no problem with me, they have a problem with God

Himself. I hear so many of them saying that God is love, and yes, God is a God of love. God is a holy God. And the Bible says we should be holy, even as He is holy I Peter 1: If the Bible says a man should not commit adultery Exodus What would you tell the homosexual community or people searching and confused? It took somebody to tell me I was wrong. That I was in sin. For me to turn my life around, it took somebody to challenge me and let me know where I was. In the process, it took them to show me in the Word. The only thing I would say to those who would disagree with me is this: Go and read the Scriptures for yourself. There are many people, not only homosexuals, living in sin. I mean, in America, adultery is all right because people say everybody is doing it. Lying is all right because everybody else is doing it. Go and read the Scriptures for yourself, and stay in it, because sooner or later, God is going to change you. People may have a disapproval of what I said, but I would challenge everybody to read the Scriptures for yourself and let the Scriptures speak to you. The coaches got rings, our wives got rings, the ticket guys got rings, the equipment guys, the trainers. Everybody got a ring. And everybody understood where they stood. How would you like people to remember you in terms of a football player and a person? For people to remember my life, Sarah, and me, as people who loved God. I want people to say that Reggie and Sarah were a man and woman of God. That would mean more to me than anything. White was one of the first to utilize this and continued it even after the NFL threatened to fine players. Tell us how the post-game prayer circles came about: Some of the guys started praying after the games together. The next year the NFL had made up a rule where they were going to stop players from fraternizing and talking after the game, which would eliminate the prayers. But when we went to London to play the Buffalo Bills, some of the Bills players and I were determined to pray. Tell us about your goals in sports, and how they match up with your goals for the other things in your life.
