St-st â€” Stocking stitch also known as stockinette stitch. Gst â€” Garter stitch. Tbl â€” Through the back of the loop. Tbs â€” Through back of the stitch. Pss0 â€” Pass the slipped stitch over. Bo â€” Bind off. Co â€” Cast on or cast off depending on the circumstances. Dec - Decrease choose your own. K2tog â€” Knit two stitches together. SSK - Slip one knit wise, slip one purl wise, knit these two stitch together through the back of loop. S2togKPss0 - Slip two stitches together, knit one, then pass two slipped stitches over. Kfb â€” Knit one stitch in the front and then in the back. Yo â€” Yarn over. Yrn â€” Yarn round needle works the same as a yo, in that it makes a hole but is most often used when creating holes between purl and knit stitches rather than knit to knit. M1 â€” Make one stitch. Also known as a bar increase. From the front, lift loop between the stitches with the left needle and knit into the back of the loop. From the back, lift loop between the stitches with the left needle and knit into the front of the loop. La-Link - Left-leaning lifted increase: Insert your left needle, from front to back, into the top of the stitch two rows below the stitch just knit. Knit into the back of this stitch La-Rink - Right-leaning lifted increase: Insert your right needle, from front to back, into the top of the stitch below the first stitch on the left needle. Place this stitch on your left needle, and knit into the back of it.
