The program consists of credits for the BSN degree, depending upon completion of a 3 credit college level Chemistry course. The RN typically transfers 60 credits through articulation agreements. Additional credits completed at other universities, colleges, or community colleges also transfer. The remaining UW -Green Bay requirements for graduation include credits of general education and support courses for the Nursing Major and 30 credits of upper level Nursing courses. Nursing students with a previous Bachelor degree from an accredited institution will be considered to have fulfilled the following general education and nursing support requirements: Having a previous baccalaureate degree does not waive the general education Ethnic Studies requirement or the nursing support requirements of Chemistry, Electives 6cr , Statistics, and Critical Thinking. How many clinicals are there? There is one practicum, Community Health Nursing CHN Practicum, which is separate from the Community Health Nursing theory class we require you to take prior to or concurrent with the practicum. The CHN is arranged in your home state as close to your area of residence as possible. Do I get credit for prior work experience? Work experience is included in the initial 60 credits you are awarded for completing an Associate Degree or Diploma program.
